AN APPEAL TO THE PARENTS

Dear Parents,

I take this opportunity to congratulate you for the success of your child to get admission in Tulsi Vidya Niketan. Certain rules have been framed by the school authorities in the interest of your child and for smooth running of the School. Please cooperate with the School in following these rules, which are given below.

1. The students will have to submit TC at the time of admission. If he / she fails to do so, his/her admission will be regarded as provisional till he/she submits TC within a period allowed by the school, which will not exceed more than one month from the date of his/her admission. Admission of all candidates who fail to submit TC on time will be cancelled.
2. Parents / Guardians must accompany their wards at the time of interview (Guardian should be a blood relation and should have a letter to this effect from the parent).
3. Parents will have to take responsibility for the good conduct of their wards. Any sort of indiscipline on the part of the student will not be tolerated and the student may be penalized or even rusticated from the school for acts of indiscipline such as bursting of crackers, breaking of school furniture, stealing things from laboratories, misbehaviour with superiors and fellow students (eg. quarreling, abusing etc).
4. Students of Senior School Certificate Examination may be allowed to change their optional subjects till the end of September of the academic year of class XI only.
5. A student will be eligible for appearing in the Session Ending Examination only if he/she has secured 75% attendance.
6. From time to time the school arranges *Parent-Teachers Meet*. It is mandatory for the parents to attend such meetings to know about the progress of their children and also to offer suggestions, if any, to the School administration.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- i) The student should complete the age of 5 years on 30th September of the year for admission to Class I but he/she should not be more than 7 years of age. The age for admission to other classes will be regulated accordingly.
- ii) Admission will be allowed after a student qualifies in the test and submits the transfer certificate of the previous school alongwith the Progress Report of the last examination passed.
- iii) The Admission Test shall be held in the following subjects.
 - A) Primary Classes (I to V) : English, Hindi, Mathematics, General Science and General Knowledge.
 - B) Class VI to VIII : English, Hindi, Mathematics, General Science.
 - C) Class IX : English, Hindi, Mathematics, General Science.
 - D) Admission to class X & XII is not usually given.
 - E) Class XI : Admission test will be conducted only for those students who have passed class X from other schools.
- (iv) The Principal will arrange the Admission Test and his/her decision on the admission will be final.

FEES RULES

1. Without Fee Card fees will not be realized.
2. If the last date of the month i.e. 30th / 31st. There is a holiday the previous working day will be observed as fee day. In case fee is not deposited within the month, a late fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged along with the dues.
3. Fee will be collected on all working days of the month without fine at the fee counters between 8.00 A.M. to 12.00 O'clock noon.
4. The students class X, XI and XII remaining absent without proper information will be fined.
5. If Fee Card is lost, it may be obtained from the office on payment of fine of Rs. 25/-.
6. If a student fails to deposit fees for three consecutive months his/her name would be struck off. The student will not be allowed to attend classes after his/her name has been struck off. He/she would allowed to be readmitted only after paying the readmission fees of Rs. 200/- along with monthly fines and regular fees.
7. Bus facility is available on certain routes. The appropriate fee should be deposited at the fee counter to avail this facility.

SCHEME OF STUDIES + 2 STAGE

The duration of secondary stage shall be two years after eight years of previous schooling. The scheme of studies prescribed for the All India Secondary School Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education is adopted in Tulsi Vidya Niketan.





Assessment Scheme for Class I to IX in the CBSE affiliated schools

The CBSE affiliated schools, for the purpose of uniformity in classes I to IX, may replicate the same assessment model as described above for Class X for Academic Year 2019-20.

Pass Criteria

For class XI, the student has to pass in all subjects in the session ending examination. He/she may be given a second chance to appear again in one subject in which the student fails. The second chance will also be treated as defaulters' examination for genuine cases.

A. Criteria for Class XI has been included in rules

- For classes IX and XI, the pass criteria would be the same as laid down in Examination By-Laws of CBSE for Class X and XII.
- Marks awarded in Project, Assignment, Unit Test and Cumulative Test will not be included in calculation of the final pass percentage but a student has to obtain a minimum satisfactory level of at least 33% marks in aggregate of the Project, Assignment and Unit Tests, to be eligible for declaration of the final results.
- To pass the examination, a pupil must obtain at least 33% marks in aggregate of each subject. In class XI, in subjects involving practical, a pupil must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical separately.
- A pupil failing in one subject in Class XI will be placed in Compartmental Examination. The Compartmental Examination will be held after two weeks of the declaration of the result.

B. Defaulter's Examination

If a student fails to appear in Annual Examination due to genuine medical problem or any other valid reason, he/she should furnish supporting documents with application within a specified date for Defaulter's Examination. After due verification by School Examination Committee, he/she may be given ONE chance to appear in Defaulter's Examination which may be arranged along with the Compartmental Examination. The criteria of passing marks will remain same as fixed for the Session Ending Examination.

If a student of class XI fails to appear in Annual Examination in one or more papers then he / she shall be treated as defaults, and has to appear in all the papers of class XI along with the compartmental Examination.
